
This Pattern Compliments of...



Curly Tendril Scarf
A fun knit, great for beginners!

Materials: 2 balls of Zitron Ethno (85% merino; 15% nylon; 90 m) or any other yarn using 4-6 mm needles (Noro Kureyon, GGH Colorado, etc.)

Needles: 5mm straight needles

- Row 1: cast on (CO) 8 stitches and immediately cast off (CF) 5 stitches. You will have three stitches remaining: 1 on your right hand needle (rhn) and two on the your left hand needle (lhn). Knit the remaining two stitches on your lhn. You have a total of three "live" stitches. Turn your work.
- Row 2: CO5, CF5, K2 (3 sts total), turn.
- Row 3: CO6, CF5, K3 (4 sts total), turn.
- Row 4: CO6, CF5, K4 (5 sts total), turn.
- Row 5: CO5, CF5, K4 (5 sts total), turn.
- Row 6: CO5, CF5, K4 (5 sts total), turn.
- Row 7: CO7, CF6, K5 (6 sts total), turn.
- Row 8: CO7, CF6, K6 (7 sts total), turn.
- Row 9: CO7, CF7, K6 (7 sts total), turn.
- Row 10-14: Repeat Row 9 (above) for 5 rows.
- Row 15: CO9, CF8, K7 (8 sts total), turn.
- Row 16: CO9, CF8, K8 (9 sts total), turn.
- Row 17: CO9, CF9, K8 (9 sts total), turn.

Continue, repeating row 17 above, until scarf measures 5" less than desired length. Begin decreasing as follows:

Decrease:

- Row 1: CO8, CF9, K7 (8 sts total), turn.
- Row 2: CO8, CF9, K6 (7 sts total), turn.
- Row 3: CO7, CF7, K6 (7 sts total), turn.
- Row 4: CO7, CF7, K6 (7 sts total), turn.
- Row 5: CO7, CF8, K5 (6 sts total), turn.
- Row 6: CO7, CF8, K4 (5 sts total), turn.
- Row 7: CO5, CF5, K4 (5 sts total), turn.
- Row 8: CO5, CF5, K4 (5 sts total), turn.
- Row 9: CO5, CF6, K2 (3 sts total), turn.
- Row 10: CO5, CF5, K2 (3 sts total), turn.
- Row 11: CO5, CF8. Finished!
