Loopy Scarf

Add some fun and vintage elegance to your wardrobe

Skill Level: Beginner/Novice

Materials:

250 meters of ribbon type yarn
8-10mm knitting needle

Directions:

Cast on 8 to 10 stitches.

Row 1: (WS) Knit all stitches

Row 2: (RS) Insert right needle into stitch, wrap yarn and bring it through like a normal knit stitch, but do NOT take it off the left needle. Bring yarn to the front between the needles and loop it around (under) your left thumb, and then take it to the back again between the needles. Knit again into the stitch that is still on the left needle, but this time do take it off. Pass the previous stitch (the one to the right of what you just completed) over it, just like binding off. This secures the loop. Repeat this across the row.

Repeat these two rows until scarf is desired length, ending with a loopy row (Row 2).

Bind off. Weave in tails.
